Summit Schools' Mission:

Summit Schools empowers each student to exceed their academic, social, and emotional goals to ensure a lifetime of success and personal fulfillment.

Objective:

To develop an individualized plan for each of our students that provides:

- * One-on-one tutoring or small groups
- * Orton-Gillingham trained instructors
- * Flexible scheduling *Online and in-person tutoring options

What is Orton-Gillingham?

The Orton-Gillingham approach was developed to teach reading to students who have difficulties with print. Characteristics of Orton-Gillingham include:

Language-Based Instruction

Children learn to understand the nature and structures of the English language.

Multisensory Instruction

Children learn simultaneously using all of their learning pathways (seeing, touching, doing), which reinforce one another. Spelling and reading are taught together.

Structured, Sequential, & Cumulative

The language is taught systematically. Sounds are taught in isolation, and then blended together to make syllables and words.

Cognitive

Children learn the history and rules of the language and how to apply them.

Individualized

Your child's program will be developed to meet your child's needs.

Tutoring/music lessons are available in the following areas:

- * Reading
- * Orton-Gillingham
- * Spelling
- * Writing
- * Math
- * Piano Lessons
- * ACT Prep
- * Study Skills
- * Spanish

We encourage parent observation of tutoring sessions. Please speak to your child's tutor directly to arrange for a time to visit.

Schedules and Policies:

2021 Sessions:

Academic - Labor Day through Memorial Day

Summer - Eight weeks, June 7 through July 31

Students are scheduled at a time convenient for all involved. This may be before or after school, during the school day or on Saturday. Sessions may be online or in-person.

We mutually expect:

- * Lessons start and end at designated time.
- * If a student does not show up for a scheduled session and has not called to reschedule, the session will not be made up and will be billed as if it occurred.
- * Rescheduling is to be done 24 hours in advance; two hours in the event of a student illness or emergency.

Fees:

One Hour Session Rates:

* 1 session/week - \$65

* 2 sessions/week \$120

* 3 sessions/week \$180

Billing:

* New students: ~~\$50 application fee after placement is confirmed, but before the first session can take place.~~ Waived due to COVID-19

* Statements will be emailed the 5th of each month and payment is due by the 1st of the following month.
