TUITION SCHEDULE

PreKindergarten - 8th Grade	
8:30 - 3:30 *Students must be 4 years old by September 15, 2023 to begin PreK. *Students must be 5 years old by September 15, 2023 to begin Kindergarten.	\$8,090 (annually)

Summit is pleased to offer a 10% multi-child discount for children in PreK through 8th grades.

Volunteerism is important to our school's mission, and also helps keep our tuition reasonable for our Summit families. We have been humbled by all those who have stepped up to help us throughout the years. The needs of Summit vary each year, and it is with the effort of Summit families that we are able to meet the needs of our school and our students.

In this spirit, we are expanding our Volunteer Co-op to Kindergarten - 8th grade families. Each family will be required to volunteer 25 hours to Summit throughout the school year, and log their time on our FACTS student information system. At the end of each trimester, our Bookkeeper will check your volunteer hours logged on FACTS for that trimester, and if necessary, bill your account the Volunteer Fee (the difference of 1/3 of the \$500 minus your hours of volunteering). Taking an active role in your child(ren)'s education leads to better social and academic success for your child.

New Student Application Fee	New students are required to submit a nonrefundable New Student Application Fee along with their Candidate Profile. This fee processes new student applications into our school databases.	\$200	At time of online application
Tuition Payment #1	All students are required to submit an online nonrefundable Initial Tuition Payment that will be applied to your child's annual tuition through FACTS. \$250 of this fee is applied to yearly tuition and secures the student's seat in the upcoming school year. The remainder is the FACTS processing fee, which new families were assessed in their Application Fee.	\$250 new students \$260 returning students	At time of online enrollment
Tuition Payment #2	This will be applied to your child's annual tuition and your contract will reflect this when monthly payments are calculated. Remaining selected payment plans begin billing on Aug. 1, 2023.	\$1,000	April 1, 2023
Activities Fee	Summit students are required to pay this fee to participate in Summit's enrichment activities (e.g.: monthly field trips, Y.A.L.E. programming, Health & Wellness activities, roller skating, theatrical programs, snow shoeing, Pod 3 Flexible Fridays, college visit learning opportunities, ski trips, fishing, community outreach, etc.). Technology Fee	The technology involved in educating a child is forever changing. Fees collected will be applied annually for technology upgrades as the school sees fit. This is billed Aug. 1, 2023.	\$260	August 1, 2023
Volunteer Fee K - 8th grades	At the end of each trimester, our accountant will check your volunteer hours logged on FACTS for that trimester, and if necessary, bill your account the difference of 1/3 of the \$500 minus your hours of volunteering. Morning Extended Daycare	Summit students are eligible to participate in Morning Extended Day (7:15 – 8:20). Drop-ins will only be accepted if spots are available in accordance with DHS requirements. Space is limited.	\$130* /month	Billed monthly
Afternoon Extended Daycare	Summit students are eligible to participate in Afternoon Extended Day (3:30 – 5:30). Drop-ins will only be accepted if spots are available in accordance with DHS requirements. Space is limited. <u>A stringent fee (\$15 per 5 minutes) will be assessed for students not picked up by 5:30 p.m.</u>	\$200* /month	Billed monthly
Morning & Afternoon Extended Daycare	Summit students are eligible to participate in Morning Extended Day (7:15 – 8:20) and Afternoon Extended Day (3:30 – 5:30). Drop-ins will only be accepted if spots are available in accordance with DHS requirements. Space is limited. <u>A stringent fee (\$15 per 5 minutes) will be assessed for students not picked up by 5:30 p.m.</u>	\$310* /month	Billed monthly
